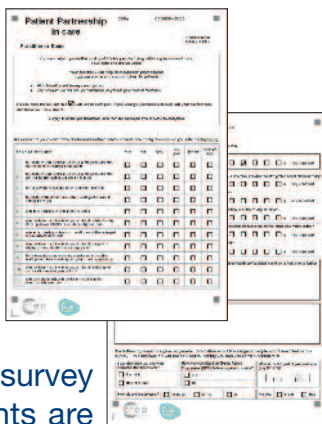

What is the Patient Partnership in Care (PPiC) Questionnaire?

The Patient Partnership in Care (PPiC) questionnaire is a 16 item questionnaire that has been developed for clinicians with an interest in supporting patients in self-management. Designed in conjunction with the Health Foundation, as part of the Health Foundation's current 'Co-creating Health' initiative, the PPiC has been designed to measure patients' perception on how their clinician empowers them towards self-care.

The PPiC measures the skills and techniques that have a known impact on the clinician/patient relationship.



The PPiC is an exit survey in which the patients are asked to provide feedback post consultation about the doctor they just saw (those of you who have undertaken a survey with CFEP before will be very familiar with this process). On completion of the survey patients are invited to return their feedback to staff in the sealed envelope provided by CFEP. Patients will not be individually identifiable to encourage patients to give their honest opinions on advice.

Once CFEP has received sufficient questionnaires the data is processed and analysed and subsequently a report is generated that is exclusively and confidentially sent to the surveyed clinicians. The report includes all written comments, summary tables (with demographics), graphs and benchmark scores from other clinicians. Support materials are also included to help clinicians act on their results and further encourage self-care.

The PPiC questionnaire is an ideal tool for nurses or other health professionals who support patients with long-term conditions (e.g. diabetes, asthma).



Why should clinicians need to review this particular aspect of practice?

PPiC will provide valuable feedback for the purposes of Appraisal and Revalidation.

Due to the nature of long-term conditions, doctors with a good skill base in aiding patients to self-care are highly regarded by their patients, enjoy both greater work effectiveness and satisfaction, and evidence shows that patient health outcomes are improved.
